

****Question****

Rule 5-2 (p. 35-36) does not clearly state that players AFTER the whistle for the draw happens:

1- can ground their stick over the restraining line to play the ball without her feet touching the line.

2- can break the plane of the restraining line to play the ball and may cross over the restraining line (after she has possession of the ball) prior to the official signaling possession

**** ANSWER ****

Ball can be played in the air **but not** on the ground, such that stick would be grounded over the line.

Draw Possession
Rule 5-2-3 Page 35

- ▶ Crossing the Restraining Line:
 - Ball may be played in the air before it crosses the RL
 - Stick may not be grounded
- ▶ The draw is completed when a bouncing or rolling ball:
 - Has touched the Restraining Line
